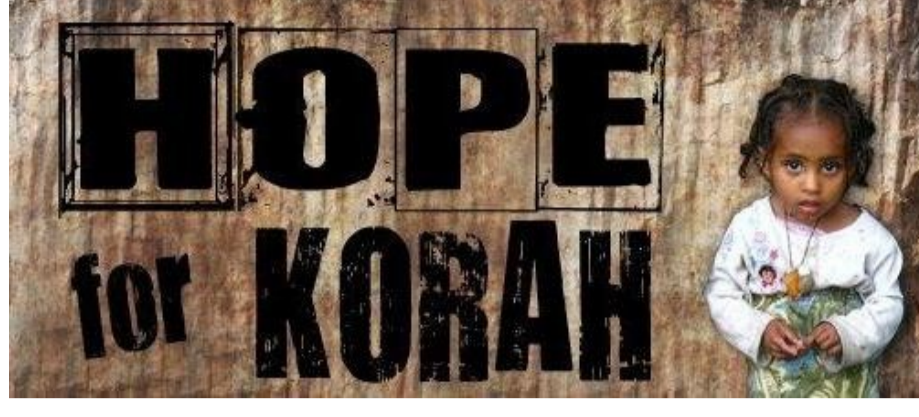


# Hope for Korah News

**IMMEDIATE NEEDS**  
for the HFK  
August 2011 Missions Trip

Since returning home in April both Dave and I have spent many hours each day working on launching the HFK Ministry, developing the on-ground programs in Ethiopia and communicating with those involved, both overseas and Canada/U.S. This has left little time for a fundraising project or raising support to cover Eve's expenses for the upcoming trip or for the additional needs which we are hoping to meet in Korah. If you are interested, below is an outline of what is needed for the upcoming August 18th – Sept 6th trip.

## Trip Expenses:

Eve's greatest expense is the airfare. While in Ethiopia we stay at a modest guest house which allows us to keep the overall costs down and food is inexpensive, which is very helpful. In planning our trip we work very hard at living simply so that each available penny (or Ethiopian Birr) can be put towards the actual needs of the people in Korah. (Each HFK team member is responsible to raise their own support. Some of you may know our 17 yr. old son Nicholas. He is also a part of the August HFK team and is raising support to cover his own expenses.) **Donations made toward trip expenses are tax deductible and if you are interested in supporting Eve or Nick in this way, please see 'Making a Donation' below for details.** Also, please be sure to add a note stating your donation is for *Eve Pohl or Nick Pohl's Mission Trip Support*. Any donations raised above the trip expenses will be used by HFK in Korah, where most needed.

## Needs in Korah:

During this trip we hope to meet some of the immediate needs of children and families living in Korah. We will be bringing suitcases full of donated supplies and we also hope to purchase additional items such as **food, clothing, diapers, medical care and prescription drugs** while in Addis.

As we are arriving just a few weeks before school starts in September, we would also love to enrol in school as many as possible of the 50 children in the Family Sponsorship Program. But this Program has not launched yet, many of these children will miss the opportunity to attend school. **It will cost approximately \$46 per year to enrol one child in school which includes their school uniform and school supplies.** It is incredible to think that such a small



amount of money (in Western standards) could provide such a BIG HOPE, yet when multiplied by 50 it does become a much bigger number!

**We are also committed to supporting the dedicated leaders of Great Hope Ministry.** When we were there this past April, these men would work hard all day, often without eating, as they themselves do not draw a salary and have little money for their own needs. While in Korah, our desire is to meet some of their personal and ministry needs such as purchasing them meals, contributing needed supplies to their ministry and filling their van with gas (they graciously drive and translate for us during our entire visit.)
